









Figure 4. BC807-16: DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values





Figure 6. BC807-16: Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values









Figure 8. BC807-25: DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values





Figure 10. BC807-25: Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values







Figure 11. BC807-25: Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values





Figure 12. BC807-40: DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values





Figure 14. BC807-40: Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values





Figure 15. BC807-40: Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values






